Item 5 – Proposed Initial Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) for All Aquifers

GMA 12 members met April 27, 2026, and voted to set the proposed initial DFCs for all aquifers within the boundaries of the Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District (BVGCD). The proposed values approved for BVGCD are listed below:

Brazos River Alluvium

- **North of State Highway 21**: Percent Saturation shall average at least 30 percent of total well depth from 2013 to 2080
- **South of State Highway 21**: Percent Saturation shall average at least 40 percent of total well depth from 2013 to 2080

**All values listed below are shown in artesian water level decline allowed on average calculated across the entire District*
