# Proposed Correction to Rule 11.1(d) – Reworking and Replacing a Well

### **Current Language**

### SECTION 11. REWORKING AND REPLACING A WELL

#### **RULE 11.1. PROCEDURES**

(d) A replacement well must be completed in the same aquifer as the well it replaces, and shall not be drilled, equipped, or completed so as to increase the rate of production of water from the well it replaces. A replacement well must not be located closer to any other well or authorized well site unless the new location complies with the minimum the spacing requirements of Rule 5.1; otherwise, the well shall be considered a new well for which an application must be made.

# SECTION 11. REWORKING AND REPLACING A WELL

### **RULE 11.1. PROCEDURES**

(d) A replacement well must be completed in the same aquifer as the well it replaces, and shall not be drilled, equipped, or completed so as to increase the rate of production of water from the well it replaces. A replacement well must not be located closer to any other well or authorized well site unless the new location complies with the minimum the spacing requirements of Rule 56.1; otherwise, the well shall be considered a new well for which an application must be made.
