Meetings and Public Education:

- Met with (Alan) four Robertson County commissioners to explain the upcoming proposed water transfer project July 11 & July 19, 2022 (two commissioners each meeting)
- Attended (Alan) virtual TAGD Water Transfers Planning subcommittee meeting July 22, 2022 & August 5, 2022
- Attended (Alan) virtual TAGD DFC/Planning Committee meeting August 3, 2022
- Attended (Alan) virtual TAGD Conservation/Waster Committee meeting August 2, 2022
- Met (Alan) with the Mitigation Plan Committee virtually July 27 & August 3, 2022
- Met (Alan) with TAGD Legislative Committee to finalize white papers created for the upcoming 87th Legislative Interim Hearing for both the House Natural Resources and Senate Water, Agriculture, and Rural Affairs committees

General Business:

- Staff worked an extensive amount of time on the UW Mitigation Plan, measuring Simsboro wells, and identifying wells that could possibly be affected in the near term from agricultural pumping northwest of Hearne, Texas
- Staff answered many calls and addressed the issue of artesian water levels dropping in wells and what can be done to remedy the situation
- Continued work identifying, incorporating, and measuring water levels in identified monitoring wells in the Carrizo Calvert Bluff, Queen City, and Simsboro aquifers
- Measured water levels in monitoring wells that are idle or not equipped to pump
- Continued to identify and gather data associated with all known Simsboro wells within a 10-mile radius of the UW Brazos Valley Farm, LLC property
- Continued to work with District consultants and permit applicant on parameters for a District mitigation plan including the funding mechanism

- Completed exempt wells in Brazos and Robertson counties were geo-tagged, photographed, and an inspection of surface completion conducted as completion notification occurred (submission of driller's log).
- Mailed all Certificates of Registration to well owners with recently located wells found in the TCEQ archived water well log database.
- Invoiced all "Production Monthly" permit holders for 2021 water production
- Continued locating wells based of archived well logs housed in the TCEQ and TWDB databases.
- Continued reconciling identified wells with proper aquifer using the virtual bore tool going grid by grid through the entire district.
- Non-exempt permit holders continue to report monthly water production directly to the ArcGIS database.
- ArcGIS map/data program updating of exempt well locations and well data.
