This application meets all of the specifications listed in BVGCD Rule 7.1 (c) regarding production based acreage. Below is the formula used to calculate and verify the applicant's compliance and was applied to each of the wells listed below:

Formula

acre feet/year x .62 = gpm on an average annual basis

Annual Average gpm x 1'/gpm for Simsboro wells = radius from the wellhead

radius x radius x 3.14 = square feet around the well

Square feet around well/43,560 = **contiguous acres to be assigned to the well.**



This application is administratively complete.


