- 1. Permit Hearing on the following Operating Permit Amendment Applications:
- One (1) existing well for Frank DeStefano Front Well (BVDO-0217) located at
  N 30.737850° W 96.576650° 0.73 miles WNW of the intersection of FM 50 and Mumford Road
  in Robertson County for Agricultural use. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit
  lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the
  Brazos River Alluvium Aquifer.
- One (1) existing well for Carey D. Smith Well #1 (BVDO-0215) located at
  N 30.682296° W 96.424667° 0.18 miles W of the intersection of FM 2818 and FM 1687 in
  Brazos County for Industrial use. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening
  the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Sparta Aquifer.
