Professional Services:

2017 Budgeted Amount - \$337,300.00 (Increase to \$412,000.00)

Increase necessary due to:

- Unexpected additional legal services required due to a SOAH hearing precipitated by a permit complaint and a lawsuit filed against the District in the 82nd State District Court (~\$66,000).
- Higher than expected expenditures for hydrogeological services partially aggravated by the SOAH issue and district court filing (~\$9,000).

Salaries & Benefits:

2017 Budgeted Amount - \$259,600.00 (Increase to \$286,000.00)

Increase necessary due to:

- Payment of accrued vacation time to Cynthia (\$7,139) and Alan (\$4,967)
- Increase to both Retirement & Medicare/SS due to payment of accrued vacation

Other Services:

2017 Budgeted Amount - \$121,800 (Increase to \$124,800)

 Travel/training expenses were higher than budgeted due to the employment of Megan Haas and educational opportunities for District staff.

It is the recommendation of the General Manager the above listed amendments to the 2017 BVGCD budget be approved.
