General Business:

- District purchased a camera for use during the 2020-2021 school year to connect virtually with a school districts replacing in-person instruction temporarily.
- Purchased a one-year Zoom subscription and began setup and use of the virtual meeting space during the COVID-19 shutdown.
- Completed exempt wells in Brazos and Robertson counties were geo-tagged, photographed, and an inspection of surface completion conducted as completion notification occurred (submission of driller's log).
- Mailed all Certificates of Registration to well owners with recently located wells found in the TCEQ archived water well log database.

- Continued work with John Seifert to identify areally and spatially diverse wells within all eight aquifers for “DFC monitoring well” designation.
- All fees for 2019 “Permit Annual” and “Production Annual” invoiced water production have been collected.
- Invoiced all “Production Monthly” permit holders for 2019 water production.
- Continued locating wells based of archived well logs housed in the TCEQ database.
- Continued reconciling identified wells with proper aquifer using the virtual bore tool going grid by grid through the entire district.
- Non-exempt permit holders continue to report monthly water production directly to the ArcGIS database.
- ArcGIS map/data program updating of exempt well locations and well data.
- Continued to expand District presence on social media platforms including Twitter and Facebook.
