1. Permit Hearing on the following Operating Permit Applications:


- **One (1) existing well for Vince Mancuso - Well #1 (BVOP-0315)** – Located at: N 31.036770° W 96.332653° 0.93 miles W of the intersection of Cobb Branch Road and FM 1940 in Robertson County for Agricultural use. The well produces from the Queen City Aquifer.
- **One (1) existing well for Midwest Poultry Services, LP – Well #4 (BVOP-0316)** – Located at: N 30.802387° W 96.245903° 0.36 miles NE of the intersection of Fickey Road and E US Hwy 21 in Brazos County. The well produces from the Sparta Aquifer.

2. Discussion and possible action on the following Operating Permit Applications:
