

Item 7c | Permits Due to be Completed

All Drilling/Operating permits issued and not drilled on or before September 14, 2023, were given three (3) years to complete the wells as prescribed in the District Rules. If the wells are not completed before September 14, 2026, the following alternatives are:

1. Relinquish permit
2. Begin paying (monthly) for permitted amount at the highest beneficial fee rate listed on the permit. This extension is for a maximum of 24 months.
3. If the well is not completed before September 14, 2028, the permit will expire, requiring the permit holder to reapply for a permit under the current District Rules.
4. The first monthly payment for extending the drilling/completion phase will be invoiced August 14, 2026, and is due by September 14, 2026.
