• **Three (3) existing wells for Jacob Bumpurs:**

Well #1 (BVDO-0234) - Located at: N 31.28696994° W 96.37015087° 0.69 miles SSW of the intersection of FM 937 and Dogwood Creek Road in Robertson County. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Simsboro Aquifer.

Well #2 (BVDO-0235) - Located at: N 31.28648894° W 96.36962725° 0.71 miles SSW of the intersection of FM 937 and Dogwood Creek Road in Robertson County. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Simsboro Aquifer.

Well #3 (BVDO-0236) - Located at: N 31.28594787° W 96.37012299° 0.76 miles SSW of the intersection of FM 937 and Dogwood Creek Road in Robertson County. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Simsboro Aquifer.

• **Two (2) existing wells for Dale Carpenter:**

Well #2 (BVDO-0241) - Located at: N 30.856583° W 96.418747° 1.33 miles SSE of the intersection of Pryor Lane and Dunns Fort Road in Robertson County. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Sparta Aquifer.

Well #3 (BVDO-0242) - Located at: N 30.859058° W 96.416000° 1.20 miles SSE of the intersection of Pryor Lane and Dunns Fort Road in Robertson County. Permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Sparta Aquifer.

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

- The Board of Directors may meet in closed session, pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code §§ 551.071-551.076, to:
- (1) consult with attorney ;
 - (2) deliberate regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the District in negotiations with a third person;
 - (3) deliberate a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the District if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the District in negotiations with a third person;
 - (4) to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a Board member or District employee;
 - (5) to receive information from employees or question employees, but not deliberate public business or agency policy that affects public business; and
 - (6) to deliberate the deployment or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices.

The Board may also meet in open session on these matters as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code § 551.102.
