 - One (1) existing well for College Station Town Center Well #1 (BVDO-0271) Located at: N 30.57752512° W 96.26834628° 0.53 miles S of the intersection of Rock Prairie Road West & Bird Pond Road in Brazos County. The permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Yegua-Jackson Aquifer.
 - One (1) existing well for College Station Town Center Well #2 (BVDO-0272) Located at: N 30.57950270° W 96.27046162° 0.38 miles SSE of the intersection of Rock Prairie Road West & Bird Pond Road in Brazos County. The permit holder seeks to amend the existing permit lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years. The well produces from the Yegua-Jackson Aquifer.
