- Identified all known Simsboro wells within a 10-mile radius of the UW Brazos Valley Farm, LLC property
- Developed a shape file containing all Wildfire Energy leases
- Developed a shape file for all known Simsboro within a 10-mile radius of the UW Brazos Valley Farm, LLC property
- Worked with District consultants on parameters for a District mitigation policy
- Completed exempt wells in Brazos and Robertson counties were geo-tagged, photographed, and an inspection of surface completion conducted as completion notification occurred (submission of driller's log).
- Mailed all Certificates of Registration to well owners with recently located wells found in the TCEQ archived water well log database.
