

Item 8 – District Water Conservation Plan Review & Re-adoption

The Board is required through the District Management Plan to:

- Annually review of the District Water Conservation Plan, make any suggested revisions, and re-adopt the plan

Following District Staff and Education/Conservation Committee review of the District Water Conservation Plan (DWCP), the following revisions are suggested for Board consideration:

- Add the red-letter wording, where appropriate, to include not only public water suppliers in Brazos and Robertson counties but to suppliers beyond the District receiving water from transport projects.

The public water suppliers of Robertson and Brazos counties **and suppliers receiving water from District water resources via transport permits** will periodically evaluate their conservation plans in accordance with State and Federal regulations to determine the extent, if any, that the plans need modification.

A copy of the currently adopted District Water Conservation Plan is available in the District File Browser.

It is the recommendation of the General Manager that the District Water Conservation Plan be re-adopted including the revisions to the Plan presented by District Staff.
