

Item 5 | GMA 12 Common Database for Reporting

- **Discussion of GMA 12 common database for water levels and water production** – GMA 12 continues to express interest in a common database supported by all districts providing water level and possibly water production data to both GMA members and the public. Halff Associates issued a project scope of work/cost and was present during the February 19th meeting to answer questions.

There was agreement among the members to begin the process of determining what information would be shared, how it would be collected, etc. between now and the end of 2026 at which time a district within the GMA would prepare a grant proposal for TWDB consideration in 2027.

Questions/Statements to address:

1. **Will there be a standalone GMA 12 website and not a website buried within another groundwater district's webpage? **Yes****
2. **We need an agreement on how this webpage would be setup and data displayed? **Agreed to work on displayed information and setup the rest of 2026****
3. **Each District will be responsible for entering the data on their own database and the GMA12 database will just reflect this data? **Yes****
4. **GMA12 website will have hyperlinks back to each District's webpage for information related to meetings and rules of the districts? **Yes. Agreed to work on displayed information and setup the rest of 2026****
5. **GMA12 centric business as it relates to DFCs etc. will be kept on the GMA12 website. Need to know who keeps this current. **Responsible party will be determined during the planning phase****
6. **If we are going to be displaying data across all the districts together, we need to make sure that if there is a difference in time or method on data collection that this is communicated somehow. **This will be addressed during setup discussions****
