Alan – College Station recommends your position in the GMA-12 meeting be to keep our Simsboro DFC at 272' of additional drawdown. No change.

I understand the BVGCD Board authorized you to go to 365' for negotiating purposes, but I view that a WORST CASE. I understand it was derived by looking at projected future demands, but those demands are decades into the future. I want solid assurances that whatever DFC we adopt is sustainable, so that we fulfill our mission of preserving the aquifer as a dependable water source in perpetuity. Five years from now, we will be in a much better position to make that determination, with the GAM updates that are underway, and with a few more years of water level measurements in our database. If a DFC adjustment is warranted then, and we have solid assurances that it will be a sustainable DFC, then fine. But please don't do it NOW.
