Item #4 - Possible District Office Remodeling Project

The Building Subcommittee met on Tuesday, August 4th at 10:30 a.m. in the District Office to discuss possible remodeling of the District Office. Suggestions were offered by the District staff on ways to make better use of the floor space and other features deemed necessary. Some of the suggestions included:

The committee is asking the Board to approve an amount not to exceed \$2500 for his services.

It is the recommendation of the General Manager to engage Mr. Harry Bostic for purposes of architectural design and bid specifications for a potential District Office remodeling project in a contract amount not to exceed \$2500.
