

Item 9c – Update of GMA 12 Regional Planning Meeting

GMA 12 representatives met in Milano, Texas January 29, 2019 to formally begin the 2021 Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) discussions. Below are those items action was action on to move the process forward:

- Options for expressing the DFC were thoroughly discussed with 4 or the 5 representatives leaning toward using reduction in artesian pressure as the standard. POSGCD would like to use Mean Sea Level as their standard.
- The Explanatory Report will once again be handled by the consortium of consultants representing each of the 5 groundwater districts in GMA 12.
- Districts will provide the following permit information to Andy Donnelly as soon as possible to facilitate model simulations by the summer meeting:
 1. Total permitted productions on all non-exempt wells
 2. Total production from all permitted non-exempt wells (2010-2018)
 3. Estimates of future production not currently permitted
- The representatives solicited a presentation from Halff Associates about the possibility of a GMA 12 common website on which all water level data from the District would be placed for public access. Further discussion will occur at the next meeting.
- The next scheduled meeting will be held Tuesday, May 12, 2019 at the Post Oak Savannah GCD Office in Milano, Texas.
