LEGAL NOTICE

The Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District (District), in compliance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code and its Rules, will receive public comment on proposed amendments to the Rules of the District at a public hearing to be held at the District Office, 112 W. 3rd Street, Hearne, Texas 77859 at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 8, 2018. The proposed District Rule amendments relate to statutory-compliant language relating to aquifer storage and recovery projects (Rule 8.10), proposed new class of exempt wells, clarifications of current definitions, export permit application, and deletion of irrelevant language (Rules 1.1(8), 1.1(27), 1.6., 7.1(b), 7.2(d)(1)(F), 8.1(b), 8.5(b), 9.2, 10.3(b)).

The District Board, at the conclusion of the public hearing, will discuss comments received and consider possible adoption of the proposed rule. Written and oral public comments on the proposed rule must be submitted to the District on or prior to the hearing date.
