

How to join and find a Zoom meeting on the computer

Below is a picture of the home page of Zoom. Here, you can create an account (recommended for easy access of video and audio, but not required) or join a meeting.



Once you have either signed in or not, you will click "Join A Meeting" on the top of the webpage. It will bring up the page below.



This is where you will enter the meeting ID that can be found at the top of the posted agenda that will be emailed to you (example below without the actual number).




If you are new to Zoom meetings, you can obtain the app now and be ready when your meeting starts at:

Hit Join. You will get a window to download and run Zoom in a different window. (see below)




Once Zoom is opened in another window, you will be able to manage your audio, video and other items. To find your settings, click the arrow next to the audio or video.
