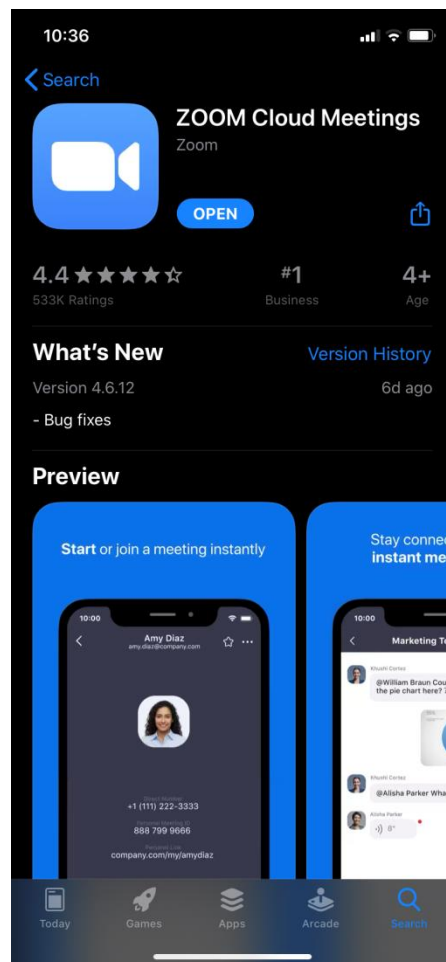


How to join and find a Zoom meeting on a phone

Below is a picture of the Zoom app from the App store on an iPhone. (Will look similar on Android and work virtually the same)



Launch the app once installed and you will see the home page below. Here you can either sign in (recommended, but not required) or join a meeting.

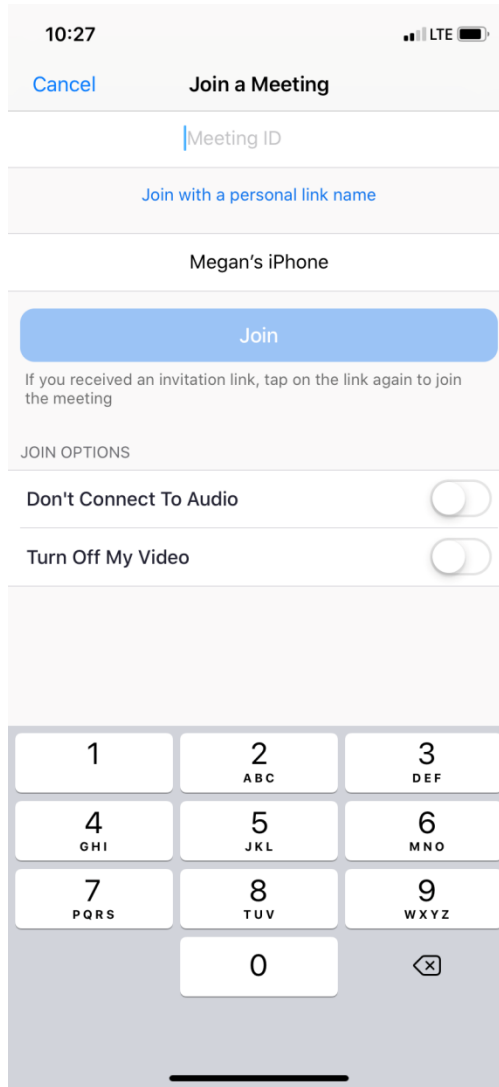

You will be able to manage your video and audio options even after joining.

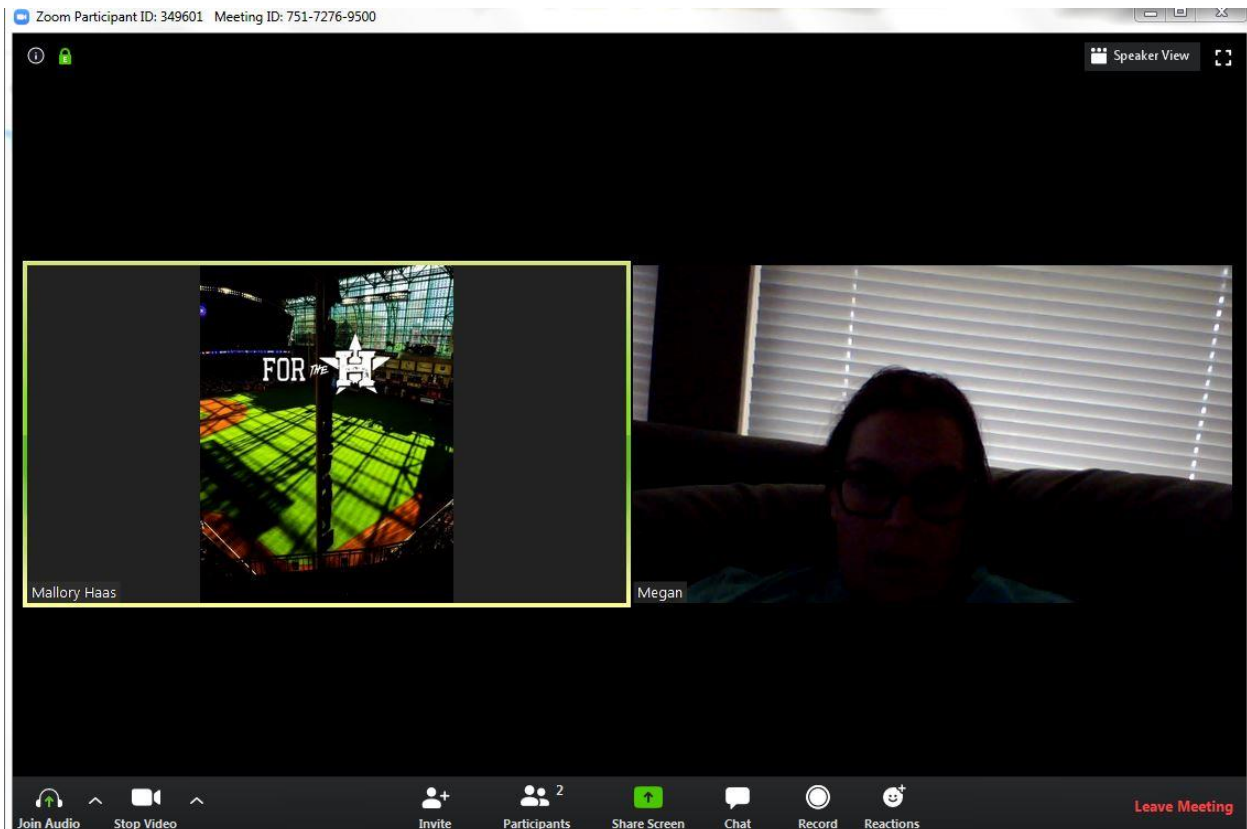

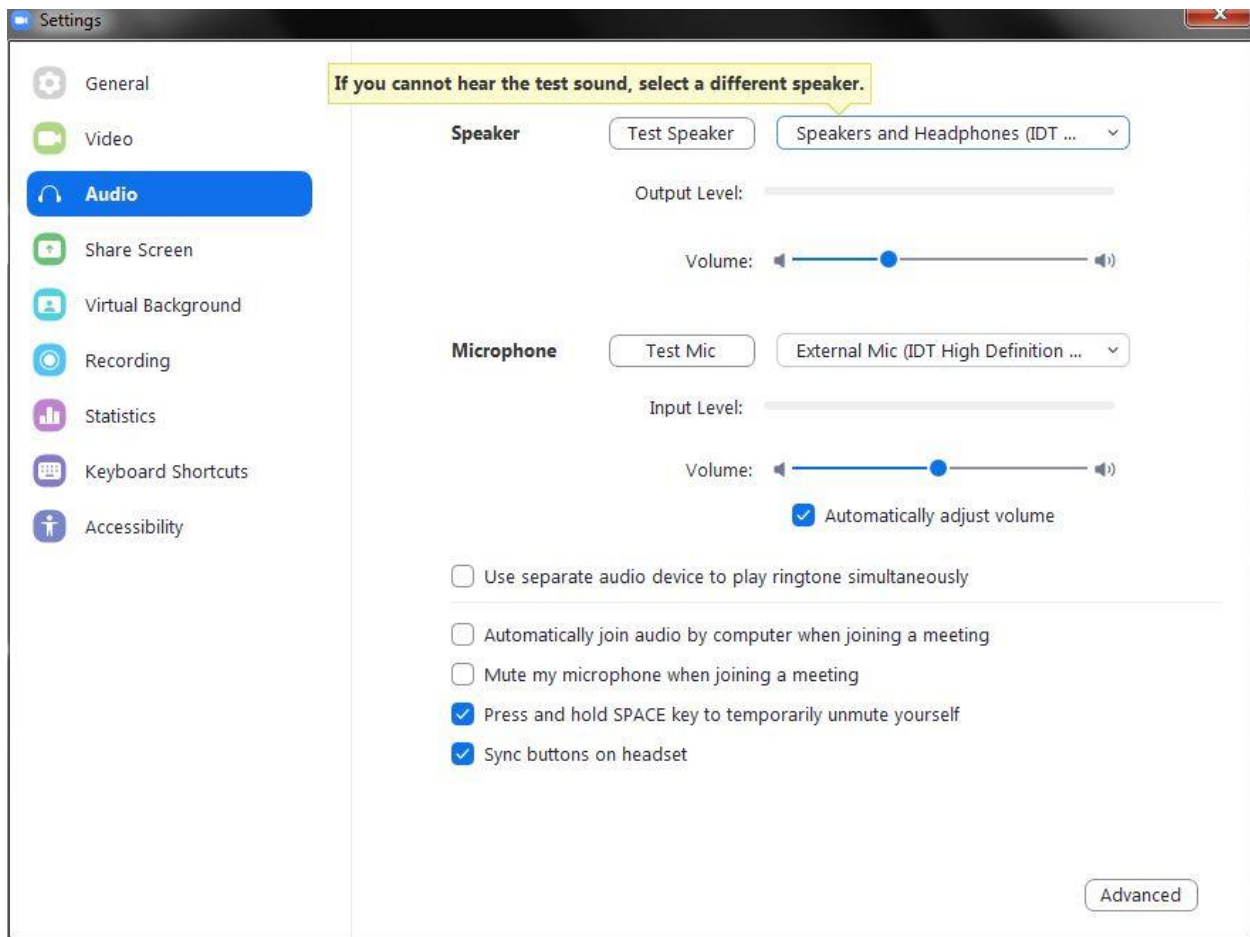
If you are new to Zoom meetings, you can obtain the app now and be ready when your meeting starts at:

Once joined, you will be able to manage your audio, video and other items. To find your settings, click the arrow next to the audio or video.



Below is a picture of the settings window where you can test your microphone and webcam to make sure that everything works for participation. As a host, we will also have the ability to mute or unmute the participants as necessary and request a hand raise for talking purposes.
