1. Permit Hearing on the following **Drilling/Operating Permit Applications:**


- **One (1) new well for Wellborn Special Utility District - Well #6 (BVDO-0284)** – Located at: N 30.756410° W 96.478019° 0.44 miles NNE of the intersection of Old Hearne Road and Bowman Henry Road in Robertson County for **Rural Public Water Supply** use. Applicant seeks a permit to produce 1,974 acre feet/year from the Siimsboro Aquifer.
- **One (1) new well for Wellborn Special Utility District - Well #7 (BVDO-0285)** – Located at: N 30.751705° W 96.475443° 0.40 miles E of the intersection of Old Hearne Road and Bowman Henry Road in Robertson County for **Rural Public Water Supply** use. Applicant seeks a permit to produce 2,139 acre feet/year from the Siimsboro Aquifer.

- (5) to receive information from employees or question employees, but not deliberate public business or agency policy that affects public business; and
- (6) to deliberate the deployment or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices.

The Board may also meet in open session on these matters as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code § 551.102.
